



Pursuant to the FIBA Internal Regulations (Book 3 – Chapter 2) approved by the FIBA Central Board on September 3, 2010:

“A letter of clearance must be obtained from the national member federation where a player was last licensed before he can be licensed by another member federation. A copy of each letter of clearance must be sent to FIBA. This document certifies that the player concerned is free to be licensed by another member federation.”

FIBA Letter of Clearance – Application Process

Canada Basketball acknowledges receipt of your request for a letter of clearance. Applications for a letter of clearance from Canada Basketball require a two-step process, including the submission of a completed application form and payment of a processing fee. The fully completed application form and payment must be received prior to the processing of the letter of clearance.

- Step 1:** Complete (in full) the attached “Letter of Clearance Application Form” and submit to Canada Basketball via email to letterofclearance@basketball.ca or via fax at 416 614 9570 attn: Letter of Clearance.
- Step 2:** Remit a processing fee of \$195.00CDN to Canada Basketball. Payment can be made by the credit card (VISA, MASTERCARD, AMEX), by completing the credit card section of the application form.

On receipt of the completed application form and payment in full, Canada Basketball will then issue the requested letter of clearance to FIBA and the member federation to which the player is transferring, provided that the applicant meets the requirements for international transfer as outlined in the FIBA Internal Regulations (Book 3). Please allow a maximum of seven (7) calendar days for processing.
