NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2016: Member of the Rio 2016 Olympic Team who placed 7th in the tournament; was the top performer in the game against China scoring 20 points; averaged 9.8 points, 5.3 rebounds and 25.1 minutes. Played her 150th international game. Played 2 exhibition games in Spain averaging 8.0 points and 6.0 rebounds. Played 3 exhibition games in France averaging 22.1 minutes, and 8.7 points. Played 3 games in the Edmonton Grads Exhibition, averaging 24.5 minutes per game, 10 points per game and 5 rebounds per game. Played 3 games in the USA Showcase tournament averaging 23.3 minutes per game, 3.6 rebounds and 4.0 points.

2015: Member of the 2015 Pan American Games team that won Canada's first ever gold medal averaged 21.9 minutes and 7.2 points per game. Finished top ten in assists and made free throws for the tournament. Played in three exhibition games in Spain and France. Helped the SWNT achieve gold at the FIBA Americas, qualifying for Rio 2016 Olympics....Named tournament All-Star... Averaged 16.3 minutes and 8.2 points per game.

2014: Averaged over 24 minutes in 9 exhibition games; in Turkey was 4th in the tournament with 12 points, 5th with 5.3 rebounds and 5th with 1.7 steals per game; averaged 10.3 points and 4.7 rebounds in over 30 minutes per game in the Czech tournament...Started all 7 games at FIBA Worlds averaging 6.1 points and 4.0 rebounds per game

2013: Participated in all exhibition games and tournaments in 2013 as well as all FIBA America games, helping the Senior Women's National team Qualify for FIBA Worlds 2014... averaging 12.5 points (highest on the team), 2.0 assists and 7.7 rebounds per game at FIBA Americas.

2012: Part of the SWNT that qualified for the Olympic Games averaging 5.6 points, 5.4 rebounds and 14.6 minutes per game...Member of the 2012 Olympic team that qualified for the quarter-finals in London, averaging 5.8 points and 23 minutes per game. Finished 3rd overall in the tournament in free throw shooting percentage.

2011: Played in all 6 FIBA Americas Olympic Qualification games in Colombia. Participated in 2 exhibition games against Puerto Rico. Played in all 12 games during phase one and two of the Senior Women's Team training camp. In Spain, averaged 10.1 points per game and 3.0 points per game in France. In three games against Japan, averaged 9.3 points per game and in China, averaged 10.7 points per game and 5.3 rebounds per game.

2010: Averaged 16 minutes, 4.5 points and 3.3 rebounds per game during the Women's World Championships in Czech Republic...Ranked 3rd in assists, top 5 in scoring and rebounds on the team.

2009: Her third season with the SWNT... Led the team in rebounds during the FIBA Americas Championship at 6.2 per game...Shot .423 during that tournament and chipped in 6.6 points per game.

2008: Averaged two points and three rebounds per game in 12 minutes of action during the FFBB Tournament. Played in all games in the Grand Prix tournament in Slovakia adding 3.6 points per game.

2007: Was second in points per game averaging 7.5 points in 11.5 minutes in 4 games at the invitational tournament in China. Went a perfect 10-for-10 from the free throw line, while grabbing 2.5 rebounds per game...Played in four contests during the Pan American Games...Averaged 7.4 minutes per game, while posting 1.5 points while grabbing 1.7 rebounds.

2005: Made her debut with the National Team Program when she participated in the 2005 Universiade.
