NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2017: After taking time off earlier in the summer, she rejoined Team Canada and traveled to Argentina for the 2017 AmeriCup, where she captained the gold medal winning team. She posted impressive numbers averaging 22.8 minutes per game, and scoring an average of 14.5 points per game. She was named to the tournament all-star team.

2016: Member of the Rio 2016 Olympic team who placed 7th in the tournament; averaged 17.3 minutes per game and 4.7 points. Played 2 exhibition games in Spain averaged 10 points per game. Played 3 exhibition games in France averaging 27.7 minutes per game, 13.3 points per game, 2.0 rebounds per game. Played 3 games in the Edmonton Grads exhibition tournament, averaging 22.8 minutes and 11 points per game. Played 3 games in the USA Showcase tournament, averaging 7.3 points per game.

2015: Played 3 exhibition games in Spain averaged 10 points in 24.5 minutes per game. Played 3 exhibition games in France averaged 8.3 points in 22.99 minutes. Member of the 2015 Pan American Games team that won Canada's first ever gold medal finished top 10 in blocks for the tournament. Helped the SWNT achieve gold at the FIBA Americas, qualifying for Rio 2016 Olympics ...averaged 16.8 mins with 10 points per game

2014: Played in all 9 of the Senior Women's exhibition games; In the Turkey exhibition tournament was 2nd on the team with 9 points per game and 3rd in the tournament with 1.3 blocks per game while leading the team with 30.3 minutes per game. Led the team in RPG at FIBA Worlds with 5.43 as well as averaging 8.3 PPG and shot .888% from the free throw line throughout the tournament

2013: Helped the Senior Women's National team take home silver from the FIBA America finals; playing 6 games and averaging 6 points and 18 mins per game... Also played her 90th international game in Xalapa Mexico.

2012: Played in all 5 games at the Olympic Qualifying Tournament where she helped the team to qualify for the Olympic Games... averaged 16 minutes and 4.4 points per game...Member of the 2012 Olympic team that qualified for the quarter-finals in London, averaging 1.2 points and 6.4 minutes per game.

2011: Played in 5 games at the FIBA Americas Olympic Qualifier... 1st overall in blocks during the Qualifiers in Colombia. Played in both Exhibition games against Puerto Rico. Played in all six games during the Senior Women's Team Asian tour in phase two of training camp. She averaged 7.7 points per game in three games versus Japan and 8.3 points per game against China.

2010: In her first year with the senior women's national squad, she averaged 12.3 minutes, 2.22 points and 3.2 rebounds per game in 2010 over all games...

2008: Played in all three games of exhibition series in China against Chinese Olympic Team... Scored 12 points on 6-9 shooting and grabbed two rebounds in 23 minutes on the floor in game three of the series...

2007: Saw action in all eight games of FIBA U21 World Championships for Women averaging 6.2 points and 6.0 rebounds...Helped Canada to best ever finish for age-group women's team with sixth place finish...Scored 13 points in win over China...Recorded 14 rebounds in win over Brazil...Saw action in all eight games of FIBA U19 World Championships for Women averaging 9.8 points and 9.8 rebounds per game...Led Canada in rebounding average, third in scoring average...Recorded 15 rebounds in win over Japan...Scored 14 points and 14 rebounds in loss to Czech Republic...Scored 12 points and 13 rebounds in win over China

2006: Played in all five games of the FIBA Americas U18 Qualifier averaging 21.0 minutes...Finished fifth in the tournament with 11 free-throws made and tenth in blocked shots, averaging 0.8...Tallied 6.6 points and 5.8 boards

PROFESSIONAL HIGHLIGHTS:

2016-17: Miranda played 27 games and a total of 734 minutes with Basket Landes and 5 games in the Eurocup in the 2016-17 season. During this season she averaged 9.6 points per game, 3.7 rebounds per game and 1.4 assists per game

2015-16: Played 30 games for Basket Landes and 13 games in Eurocup... averaging 18.8 minutes per game, 11.4 points per game, and 4.7 rebounds per game...Received Eurobasket.com All-Eurocup Honorable Mention and went to the Eurocup semifinals.

2014-15: Played 26 games for Toulouse...Averaging 32.7 minutes per game, 14.6 points per game, 5.5 rebounds per game, and 1.2 assists per game.

2013-14: Played 23 games for Toulouse... 6th in points (14.8), 8th in defensive rebounds (5.1), 6th in blocks per game (1.0), 10th FT% (91.5%) per game in the France- LFB

2010-11: Made her professional debut with Alanya in the Turkish league. Played 22 games and averaged 12.8 points and 8.1 rebounds per game... Signed with the Tulsa Shock of the WNBA as a free agent. Appeared in three games, averaging 1.3 points and 2.3 rebounds per game.

SENIOR (2009-10): Named Nation's Top Division I-AAA Women's Basketball Scholar-Athlete ... The senior center was named to the All-West Coast Conference (WCC) first team in 2010 for the third time, becoming only the fourth player in Pepperdine history to earn first team honors three times and the first since 2002 ... She was two-time WCC Player of the Week and made the All-Tournament teams at the WCC Championships and the Arizona State Classic ... Pepperdine University Athlete of the year ... She became Pepperdine's all-time leader in career blocked shots with 182, and tied the single-game record with nine ... Appears prominently elsewhere in the career records lists, ranking fifth in field goals made (581), sixth in games played (119), eighth in points (1,377) and eighth in rebounds (735)

JUNIOR (2008-09): Made the All-WCC first team for the second time as a junior ... Named to the All-Tournament teams at both the Timeout 4 HIV/AIDS Tournament and the Rainbow Wahine Classic ... Was selected as Pepperdine's Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year, made the CoSIDA/ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District third team and was on the WCC All-Academic team for the second time ... Earned WCC Commissioner's Honor Roll "silver" honors ... Named to the Arthur Ashe Jr. Sports Scholar second team.

SOPHOMORE (2007-08): Led Pepperdine squad in rebounds per game and field goal percentage, second in points per game, selected first team All-Conference, earned WCC All-Academic honors... 2nd in WCC in rebounding, 1st in FG%...19th in NCAA in FG%... Top 50 in NCAA in blocks per game (1.96)
