NATIONAL TEAM HIGHLIGHTS:

2011: Participated in 6 games at the FIBA Americas Olympic Qualifiers in Colombia... 3rd overall in assists during the FIBA Olympic Qualifier tournament. Played 2 exhibition games with the Senior Women's National team in Puerto Rico. Returned to the National Team Program after eight years... Participated in all 12 games during phase one and two of the team's training camp... Averaged 8.0 points per game in Spain; while averaging 11.0 points in three games in France... Against Japan, averaged 6.3 points per game and 3.7 points per game versus China.

2003: Member of the Senior Women's National Team at the FIBA Americas Olympic Qualification Tournament... In four games, averaged 10.0 minutes, 3.3 points and 2.3 rebounds... Recorded totals of 4.6 points and 2.6 rebounds in seven games as a reserve at the Pan American Games... Tied for fourth on the team in rebounds.

2002: The second leading scorer on Canada's Young Women's National Team at the FIBA Americas World Championship Qualification Tournament... Among the leaders in rebounding, assists and minutes... 2005-06: Averaged 11.9 points per game and a career-best 7.1 assists per game in 34 starts for Utah... She, along with teammate, Kim Smith led the Utes to the Elite Eight in the NCAA National Championship Tournament.

2004-05: Shared Mountain West Conference Player of the Year honors with teammate Kim Smith ... named first-team all-MWC ... tabbed as honorable mention All-America by the WBCA ... garnered third-team All-America honors from Full Court Press ... started all 34 games ... ranked second on the team in scoring, rebounding steals and blocked shots... led team in assists, free throws made and minutes played ... ranked No. 6 in the nation and led the MWC in assists, averaging 6.5 per game ... led the MWC in assist-turnover ratio ... ranked third in the league in scoring, averaging 14.9 points per game ... was ranked in the top 10 in the conference in scoring, rebounding, assists, steals, three-point field goal percentage, three-pointers made, assist-turnover ratio and defensive rebounds ... scored in double figures 26 times ... recorded six double-doubles.

2003-04: Started all 31 games ... second-team All-MWC pick ... named to the all-tournament team at the MWC Tournament ... led the team in assists and blocks, ranked second in points, points per game, rebounds, rebounds per game, offensive rebounds and defensive rebounds, and third in three-point field goal percentage and steals ... reached double-digit scoring 20 times ... had four or more rebounds in 24 of 31 games ... had five or more points in all but one game ... had two or more assists in 25 of 31 games ... had one or more steals in 21 games ... had one or more three-pointer in 24 games ... ranked third in the MWC in assist/turnover ratio, fourth in assists, seventh in three-point field goal average, 10th in scoring and three-point field goal percentage and 14th in rebounding ... led the team in assists 13 times, in blocks 11 times, in steals nine times, in rebounding seven times and in scoring seven times ... named to the all-tournament team at the Fresno State Classic after averaging 11.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 7.5 assists ... scored 24 points and grabbed eight rebounds in the season opener against Southeast Missouri State ... scored 25 points at CSU on Jan. 17.

2002-03: Started all 31 games ... named second-team all-MWC ... led the team in assists, minutes played and defensive rebounds, ranked second in scoring, steals, field goals made, three-point field goals made and free throw percentage, and third in three-point field goal percentage and rebounding ...
